World Outgames 2009 gets a confectionary tribute

Denmark's oldest confectioner, La Glace, has made a commemorative cake especially for World Outgames 2009 in Copenhagen.

World Outgames will be held in Copenhagen from the 25th July to the 2nd August 2009. The event promotes diversity and the basic human right to love irrespective of gender, faith and sexuality.

In support of the event, more than 60 famous Danes have agreed to be World Outgames "Star Ambassadors". Marianne Stagetorn Kolos, owner of La Glace, is one of them.

"I believe strongly in diversity. Surrounding yourself with diversity gives you a rich life. If participating might help change things just a little, I'm in," said Marianne Stagetorn Kolos explaining why she commissioned the special cake.

Head confectioner, Lars Juul, made the cake just a little different from the more traditional cakes at La Glace.

"I wanted to make a cake that had an element of freshness to it. I knew that the World Outgames star would be used as decoration and that the event color orange should come as a surprise between the layers," said Lars Juul. "The cake is soft and crisp, hard and sweet – precisely like all the lovely people, who will be coming to Copenhagen next year to participate in the World Outgames".

The World Outgames cake consists of 2 chocolate bases with crunchy almond-fudge praline between them. They are covered by a praline mousse with a taste of apricot jelly. The cake is decorated with dark chocolate ganache and an orange marzipan star.
